We share a bond that time and distance can never break apart.*

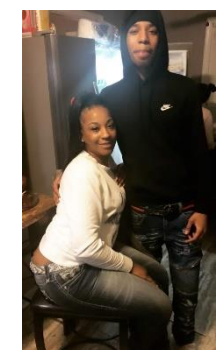
*Son, oh how my heart aches so.
