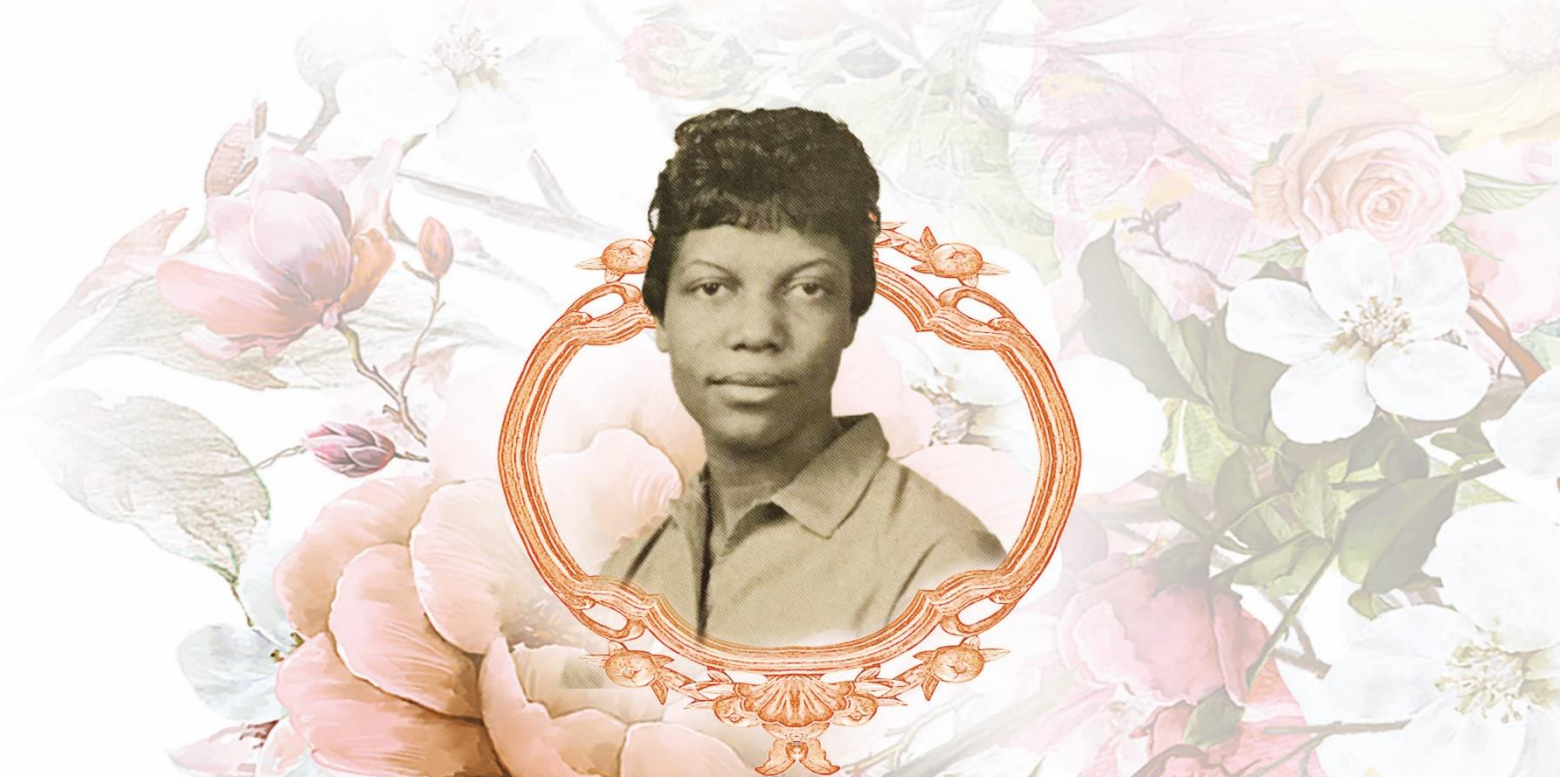
JACQUELINE MARIE DOUGHTY,
