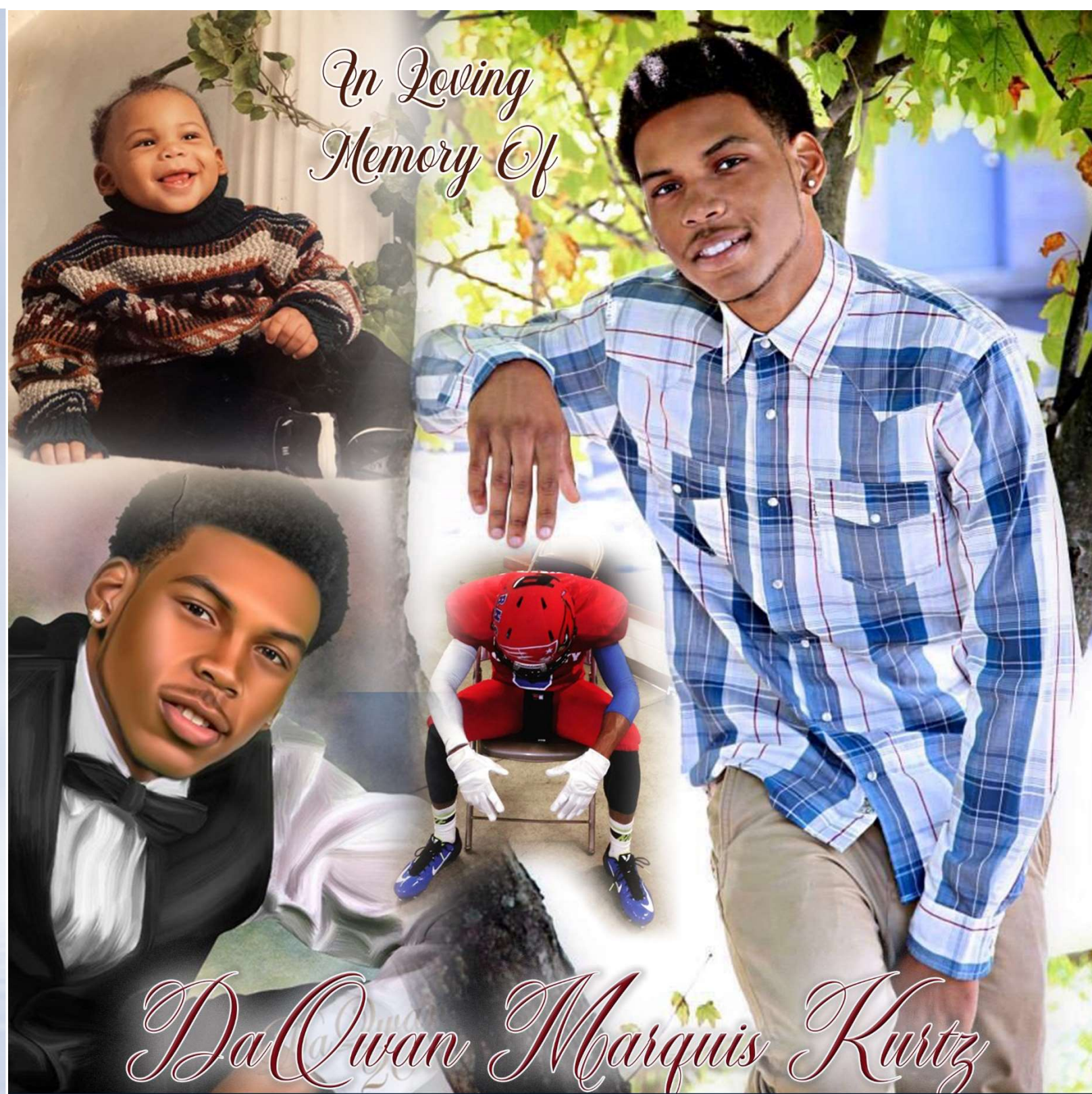

# Obituary

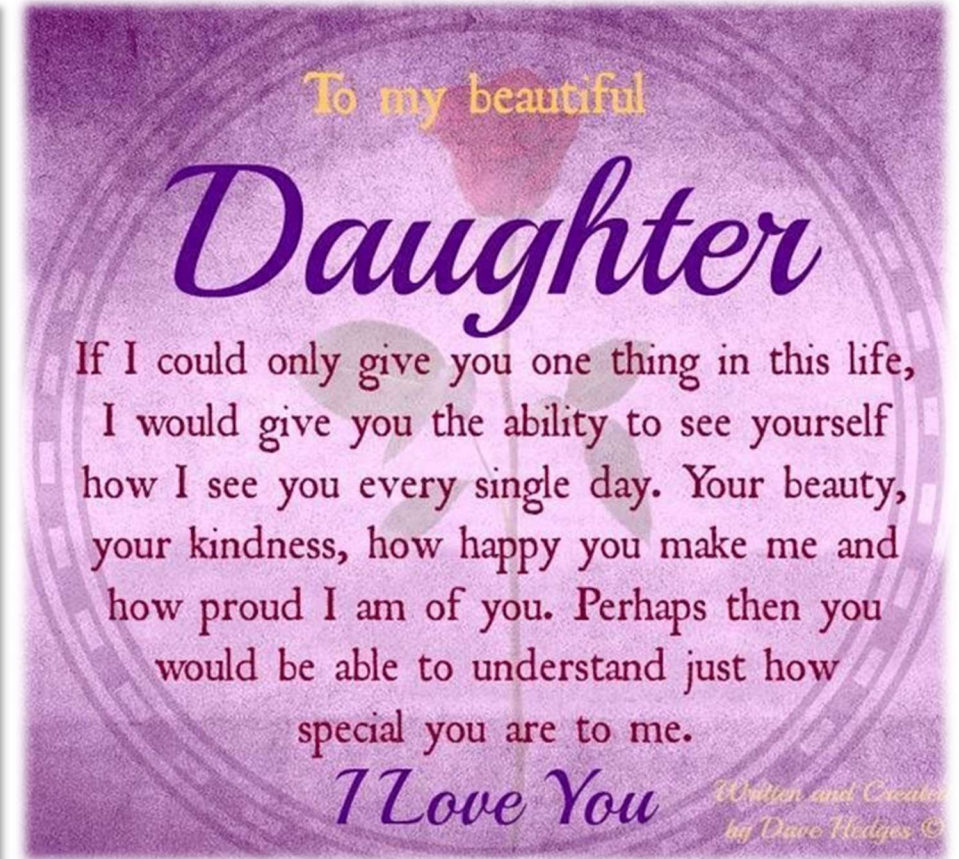

realized we'd been blessed from above.

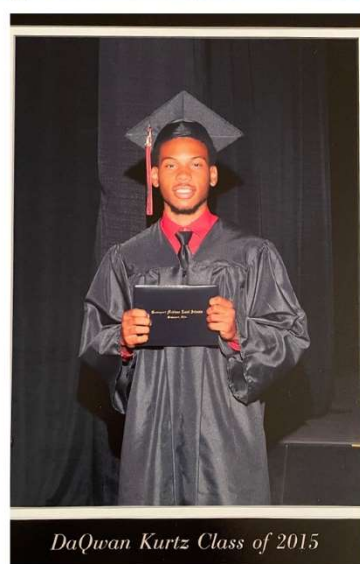
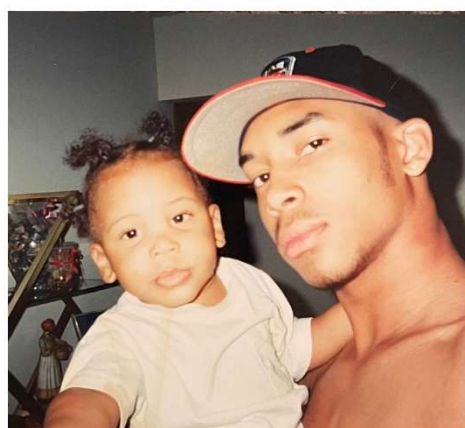
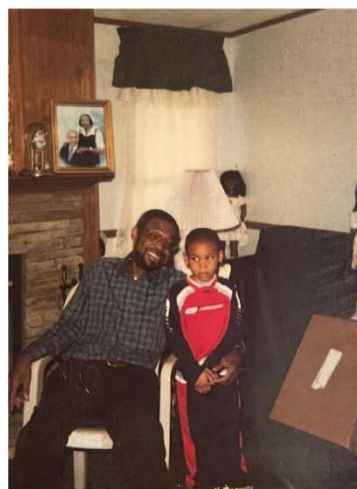
In my womb you were growing slowly, but
