too will miss.

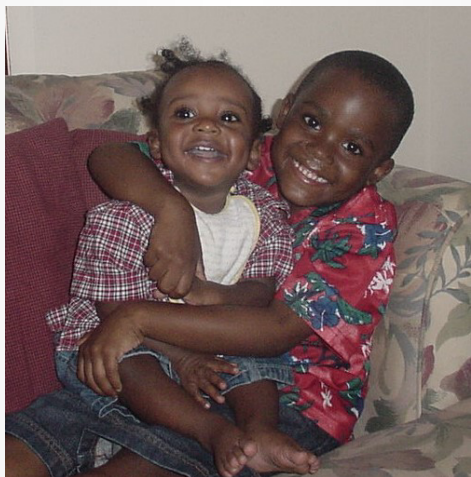
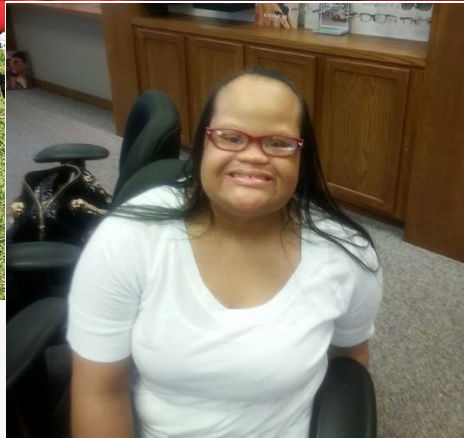

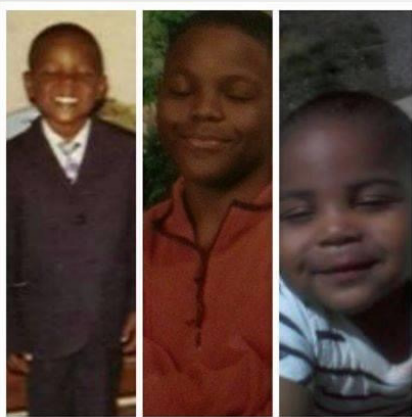
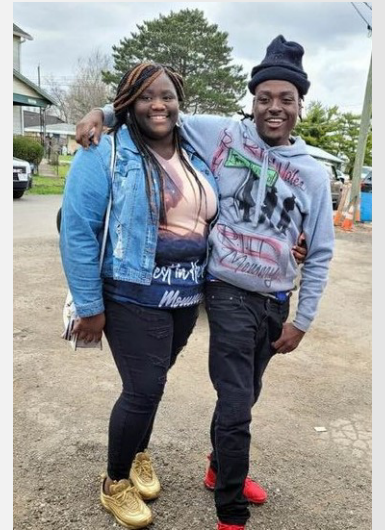
My life has been full, I savored much, Good friends, good
