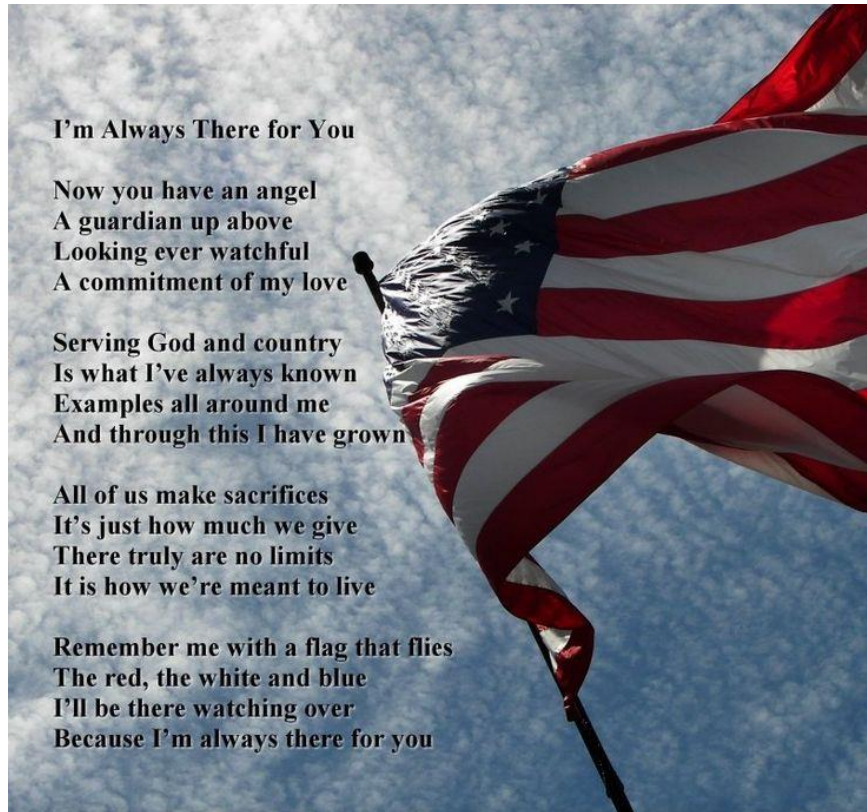

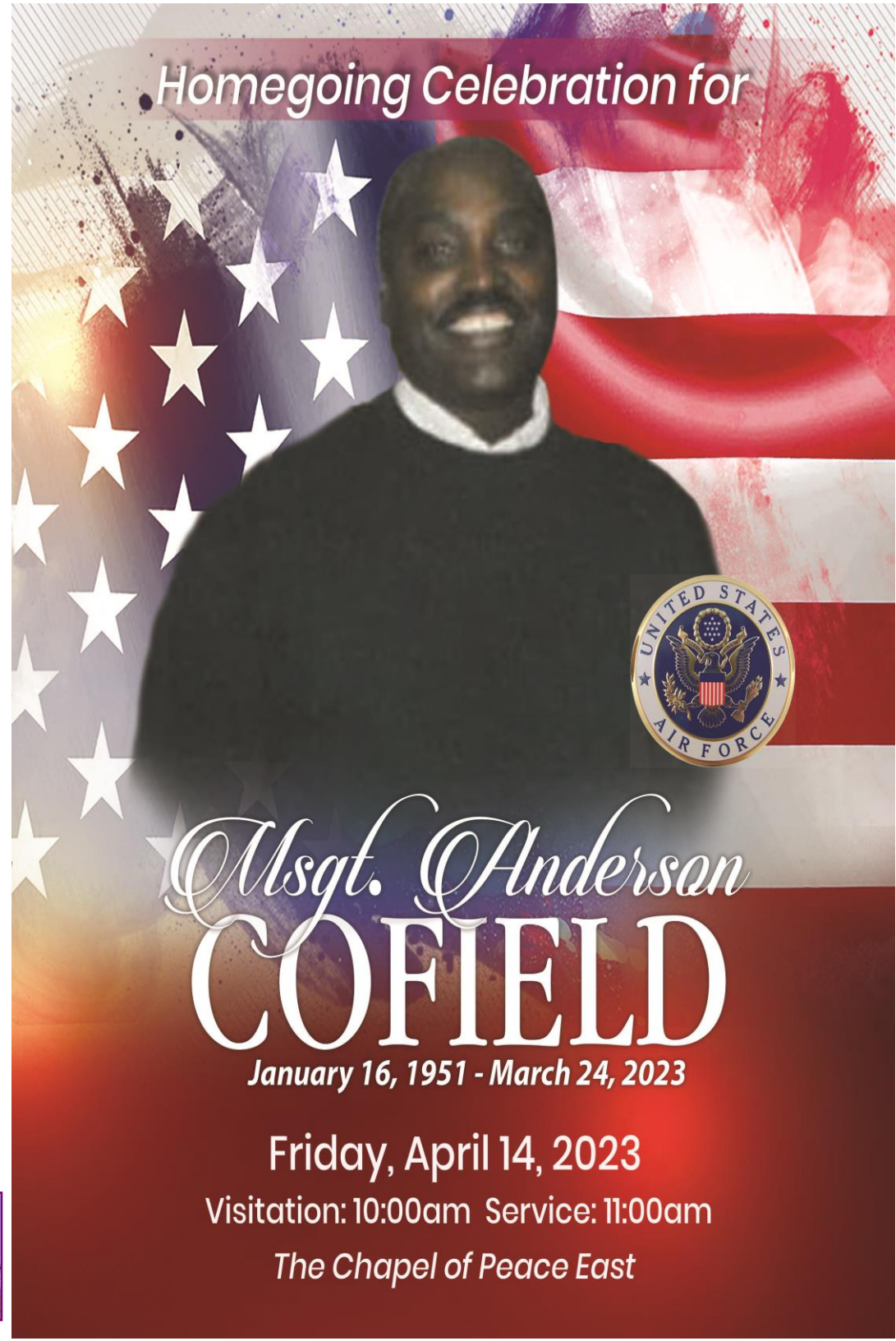

# Obituary
