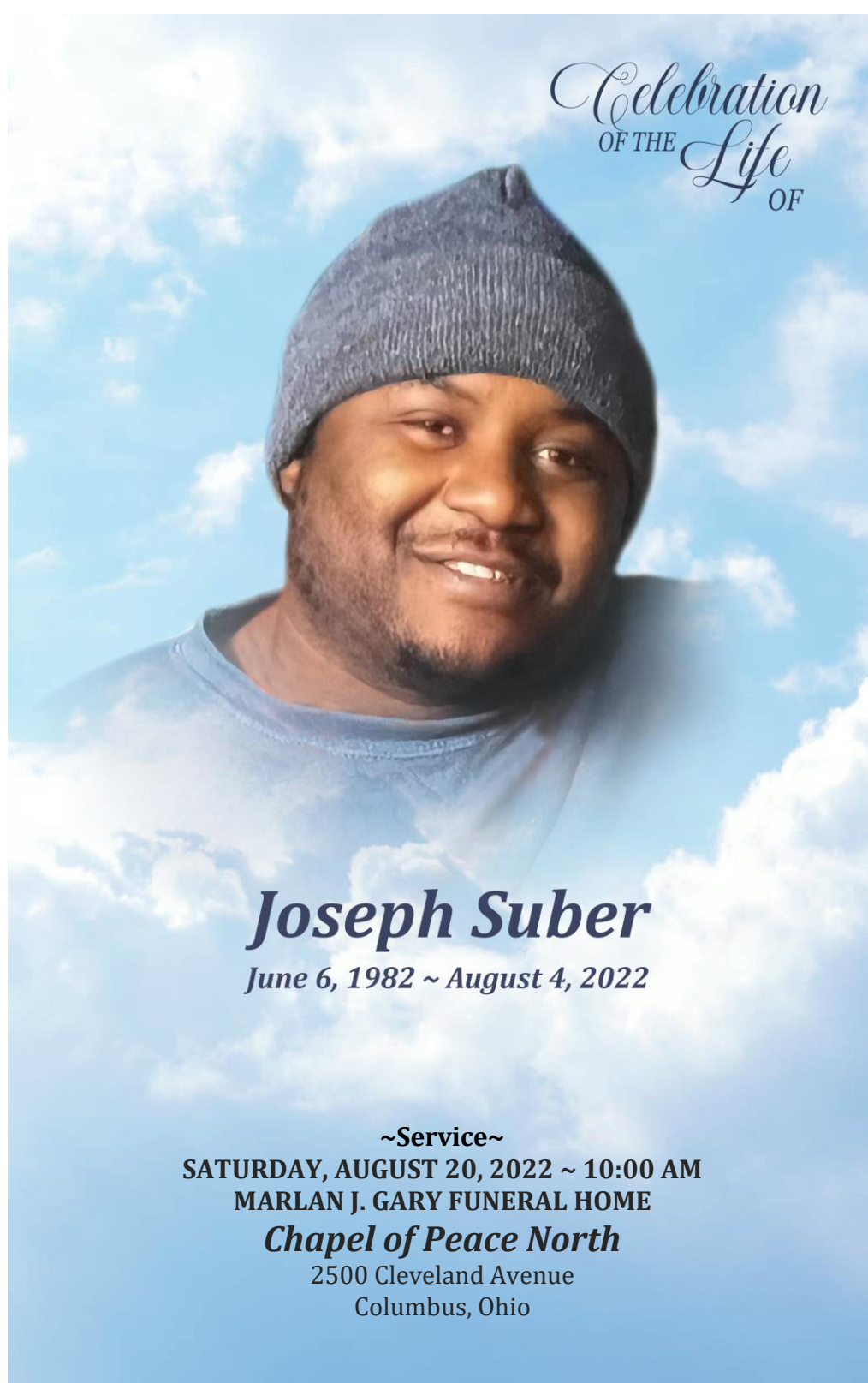
Afterglow
