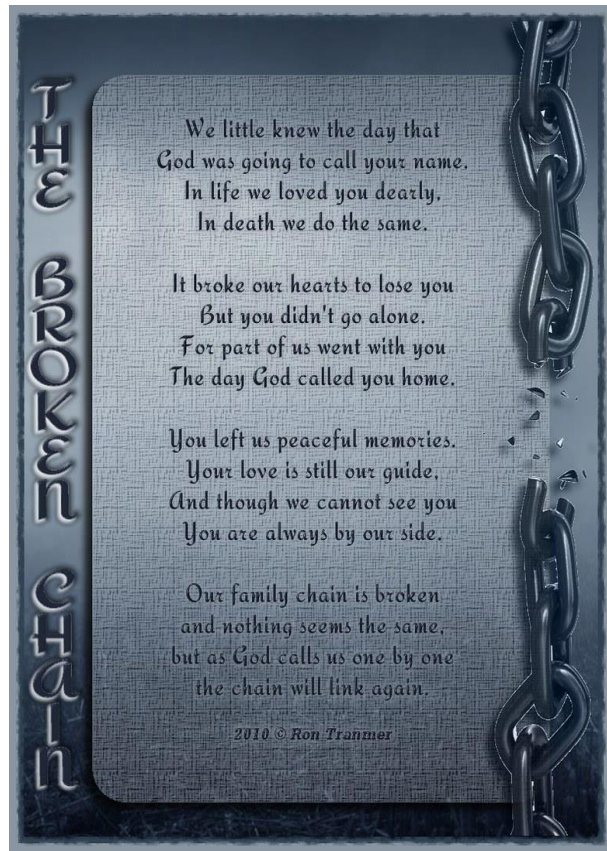


Expressions of Gratitude

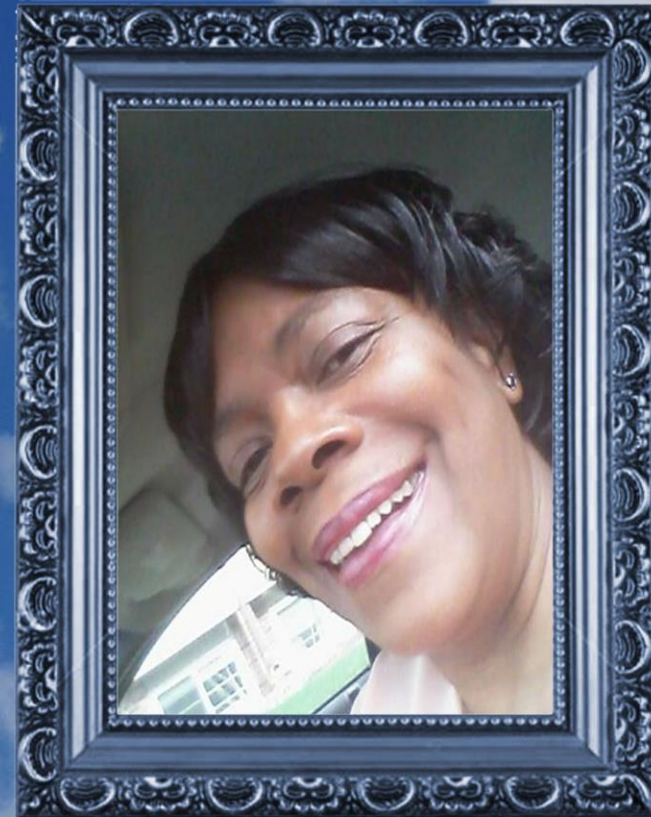
