"Cherish those you have in your life because you never know when they wont be around anymore sisters are so special from young ones to old life gave me a sister more precious than Gold"

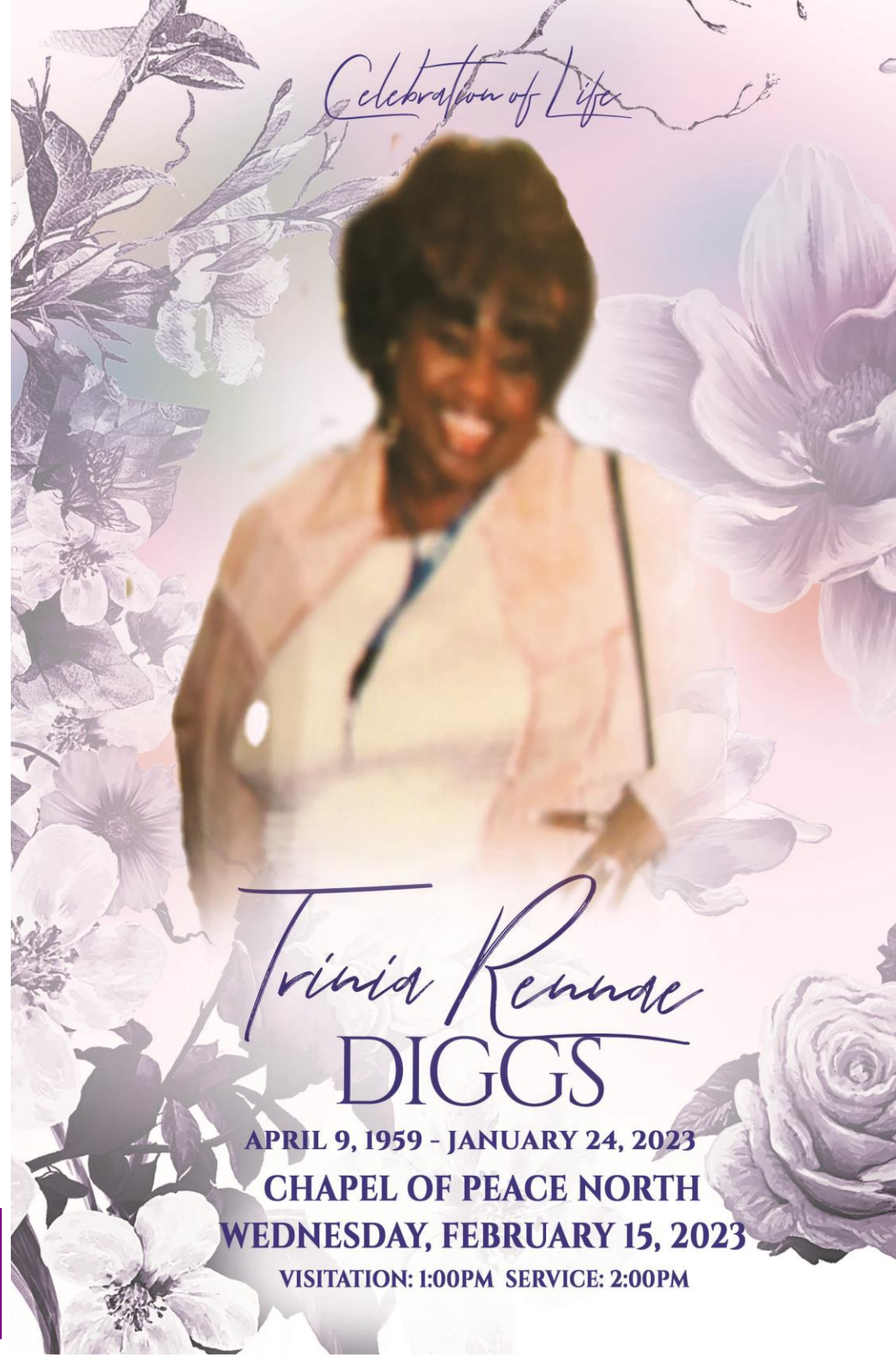
