You're always by our side*

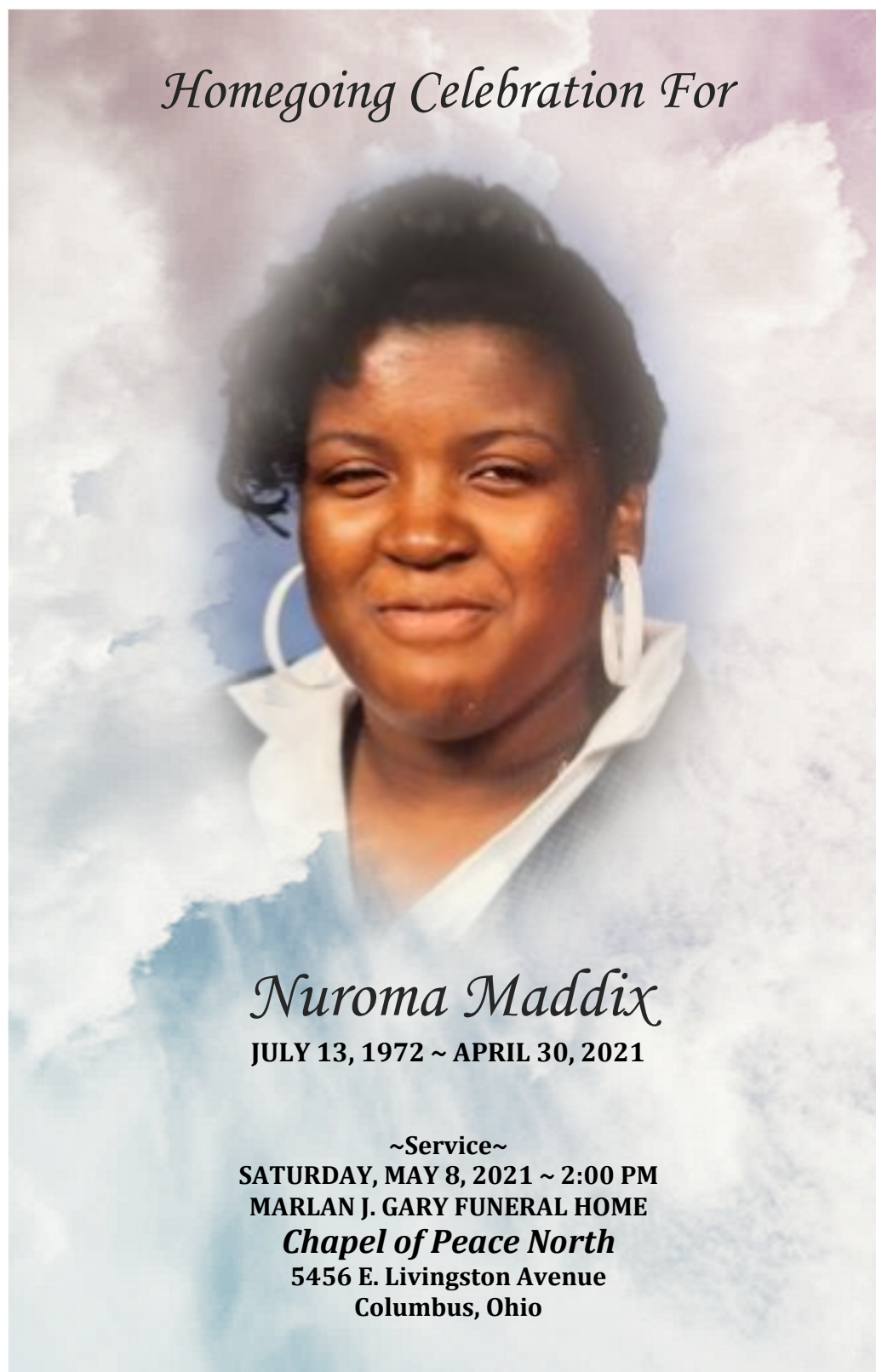
*Our family chain is broken
